Tabor, Ontario, Rockton, Union Center, Valley, Valton, Wilton, Wonewoc, Yuba and everywhere in between. The Award will typically be presented at a public meeting in the fall to which the community is invited to honor and celebrate the recipient. The decision of the Nominations Subcommittee of the Mission Committee is considered final.
